CRITERIA FOR THE 2018 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Eligibility

At a minimum, an eligible applicant must:

1. be an undergraduate student;
2. not be a former National Association of Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) Title III Administrators Scholarship recipient;
3. be enrolled full-time as an undergraduate at one of our member institutions and must have completed at least 15 credit hours at the undergraduate level prior to submission; and
4. have a (minimum) cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.

Application Submission Requirements

- In an effort to increase efficiency, we highly recommend and encourage all applicants to use the [online application process](#). In order to complete the [online application](#), the Title III Program Director or the applicant must create or use a Google (Gmail) account. The recommended account setup is to use your institution's name or abbreviation and Title III (t3) as the name for the email (e.g., jdut3@gmail.com).
- All online applications must be submitted **no later than Friday, September 7, 2018**. Transcripts can be submitted electronically to nahbcut3ascholarship@gmail.com or mailed to:

- It is recommended that all documents to be uploaded are completed prior to beginning the online application process. This will help to reduce the number of times an application is entered into the system.
- If you choose to mail your application packet, please submit a request for an application packet to nahbcut3ascholarship@gmail.com. **All documents must be received no later than Friday, September 7, 2018 or postmarked no later than Monday, September 3, 2018**. The applicant should not submit an online application and mail the same application packet.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted, and the application period is not anticipated to be extended. **All applications received after Friday, September 7, 2018 and postmarked after Monday, September 3, 2018 will not be accepted**. A printed transcript may require a few days or a
