

MULTIPLE YEAR OBJECTIVES

If the objective is going to take more than one year to accomplish, the final desired outcome (number or percentage) should be divided by the number of years projected to complete the final outcome and this number or percentage will be doubled each year to calculate the desired outcome for the objective. For example: An activity's overall desired outcome is 50.00% completion in four years (divide 50.00% by FIVE (5) to get the number or percentage of completion for each year).

- First Year- a desired outcome of 10.00% completion;**
- Second Year- a desired outcome of 20.00% completion;**
- Third Year- a desired outcome of 30.00% completion, and,**
- Fourth Year- a desired outcome of 40.00% completion;**
- Fifth Year- a desired outcome of 50.00% completion, during the final year.**
