Course Description

Facilitators will also discuss the most recent Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Audit Compliance Supplement.

This course is intended for anyone interested in keeping their grants management knowledge current, including staff from federal awarding agencies; state, local, and tribal governments; nonprofit organizations; community colleges and universities; and audit organizations.
